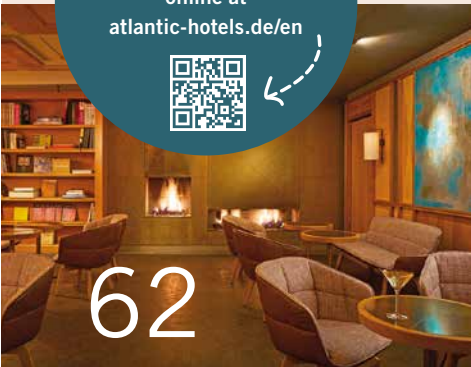

Right in the centre of Bremen is a place brimming with history, culture and charm: the market square. Surrounded by magnificent façades and the Town Hall UNESCO World Heritage Site, it is one of the most beautiful squares in the whole of Europe. The Gothic town hall with its exquisite Renaissance façade is testament to the former might of the Hanseatic League. Just a few steps away is possibly the city's most famous quartet: the Town Musicians of Bremen. Standing on each other's backs are the donkey, dog, cat and rooster from the popular fairy tale of courage and solidarity between strangers and friends.

## SIP BY SIP

Whether it's coffee, beer or wine, Bremen certainly knows how to serve a good drink. Inspired by imported coffee, the first coffee house in all of Germany was opened in Bremen, Beck's beer conquered the whole world and the historic Ratskeller wine cellar is home to the largest collection of German wines in the world. Today, tradition meets trends: not only do roasting houses attract visitors with a peek behind the scenes but craft beer breweries and gin distilleries also host tasting events and workshops.

When the sun glistens on the water, Bremen's Schlachte turns into the liveliest part of the city.

The historic harbour quay is lined with beer gardens, cafés and restaurants, all offering magnificent views of the Weser. It truly reveals its fairy-tale side in Advent, when Schlachte-Zauber transforms the promenade into a romantic Christmas market.

### WORLD HERITAGE AT YOUR FINGERTIPS

The “Queen City of the Hanseatic League” enchants visitors with its Old Town, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987. The seven church towers, winding alleys and splendid gabled buildings are an enduring testament to medieval urban architecture. The clear separation between the merchants’ and craftsmen’s neighbourhoods, still evident today, is particularly impressive. Of the around 180 alleys and courtyards that once housed Lübeck’s working population, approximately half are still preserved in the Old Town today. Many are also open to the public and lined with lovingly restored “Ganghäuschen” (alley houses). This medieval labyrinth is teeming with hidden treasures.

Right in the heart of Lübeck's Old Town is a place uniting history and indulgence: the Marzipan Museum.

The stage mill dating from 1863 is lovingly maintained by voluntary millers, who offer insights into the history of this charming landmark on a guided tour. The Kopperhörner Mühle, originally built in 1547 and later converted into a smock mill, has an integrated museum demonstrating how corn was ground to produce flour in days gone by. In addition to historical milling equipment, the mill impresses with its working technology and a dedicated team. Guided tours are available on selected Saturdays.



## THE SOUNDS OF THE SEA

**The coastline around Wilhelmshaven offers  
an impressive selection of beaches – each with its own charm.**

Schillig boasts a broad, fine sandy beach with a view of the UNESCO Wadden Sea World Natural Heritage Site. A special detail with a contemporary link is the cast-iron stove plate with the inscription "Pax optima rerum" – peace is the greatest good.



## ON PICASSO'S TRAIL

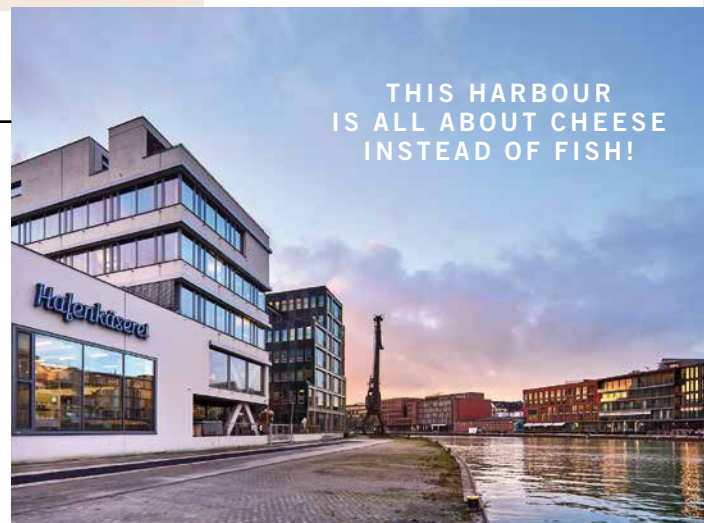
**Germany's only museum dedicated to Picasso** is located in the heart of Münster's Old Town and a real gem for art lovers. A world teeming with colour, shapes and history unfolds behind its protected historic façades. The collection contains more than 800 lithographs by Pablo Picasso, along with works by contemporaries such as Braque, Matisse, Chagall and Miró. Rotating temporary exhibitions showcase Picasso's graphic work in dialogue with painting and sculpture. The holiday programme for children and creative workshop for museum visitors are particularly popular.

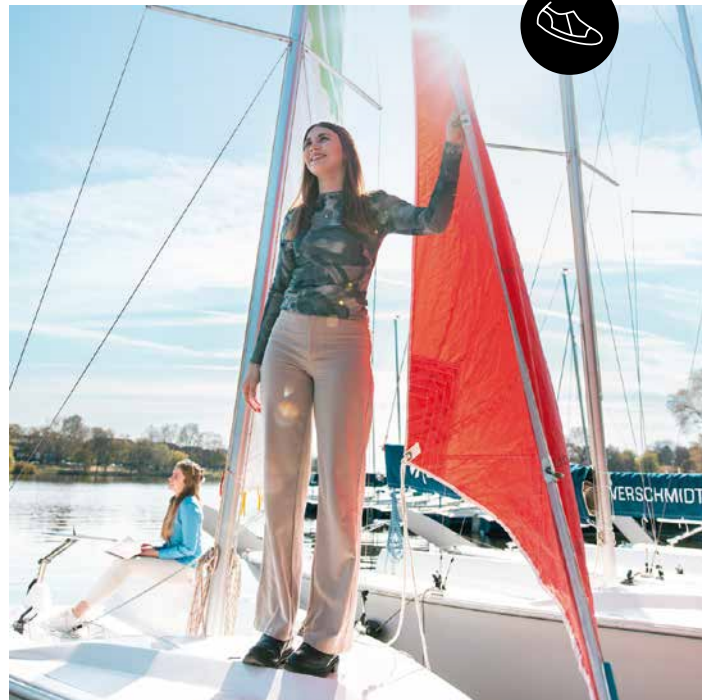

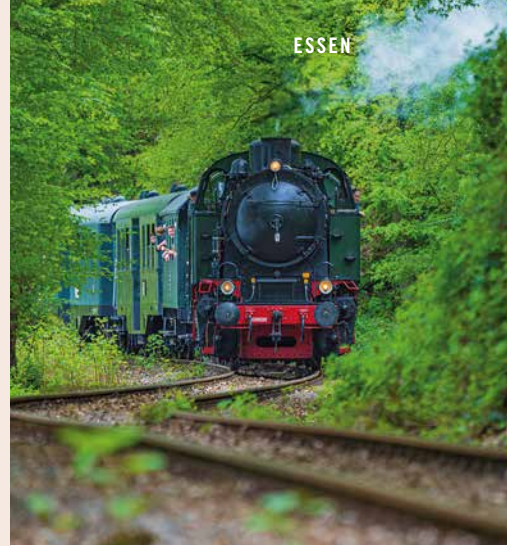

The striking double-headframe tower of Shaft XII – a symbol of industrial prowess and modernist architecture – is particularly well known. The complex was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2001 and has since transformed into a vibrant cultural centre. With its museums, design centres, events and nature experiences, it has become a popular place to visit in the Ruhr region.
